## INTRODUCTION

This list of the periodical holdings of the CDE Library supersedes CDE Working Paper 86-5.

As this is a list of holdings, not just of titles currently received, the user should look carefully at the citation for years or volumes in the collection. Incomplete runs are indicated by an asterisk. Titles currently being received have an open-ended dash after the year or volume of the first issue held; e.g., 1:1969- . Titles which are no longer received have a final year entered after the dash; e.g., 1:1969-1974. In most cases the reason for closed runs is given: i.e., "ceased publication" or "replaced by ..."

Titles are arranged in a word by word alphabetical sequence. Initialisms, e.g., NBER, are treated as a word and arranged accordingly. Articles at the beginning of a title are disregarded.

Addresses for ordering subscriptions or requesting information on the availability of titles are included wherever possible. In the case of discontinued publications, only the issuing or sponsoring agency is listed. No attempt has been made to give prices as changes are too frequent.

ISSN information is a new addition to this revision of the periodical holdings list. Numbers are taken from publication information provided on the periodical itself. It is hoped this information will give users more complete bibliographic information.

The CDE Library subscribes to a number of indexing and abstracting journals in demography and related fields. Other bibliographic tools and services are available on the University of Wisconsin-Madison campus. Local users should consult with the Librarian or Library Assistant when considering a search strategy.
